## Location Changed, Time Set for Gallatin Meeting about Wolf Creek Dam and Center Hill Dam

**NASHVILLE, TENN. (February 13, 2007)** – The US Army Corps of Engineers, Wolf Creek Dam and Center Hill Dam February 15<sup>th</sup> public meeting location in Gallatin, Tenn., has been changed. Gallatin Civic Center, located at 210 Albert Gallatin Avenue is the new location. Maps indicating areas of potential flooding in **Sumner County only** will be available at 3:00 p.m., and the meeting will start at 6:30 p.m. and last until 8 p.m.

The presentation will address the planning, design and construction efforts to manage the seepage at both Wolf Creek and Center Hill Dams. Inundation maps are also available at the Martin Curtis-Hendersonville Public Library, 116 Dunn St., and Edward Ward Carmack-Sumner County Public Library, 658 Hartsville Pike, Gallatin, TN 37066-2509.
