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CORPS ACCEPTING BIDS FOR SALE OF TIMBER

AT LAKE CUMBERLAND

NASHVILLE, TENN., Feb. 6, 2008 –The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will begin accepting bids on February 22, 2008, for the removal of timber on approximately ten (10+/-) acres of lands located 3 miles from Jabez, Kentucky. The ten acre tract contains an assortment of Hickory, Sugar Maple, White Oak, Red Oak, American Beech, Miscellaneous, Yellow Poplar, Black Gum, and Ash. A total of approximately four hundred and eighty trees have been made available for sale and removal. The trees have an estimated total of more than 91,000 broad feet with all cutting to be completed by 31 March 2008.

The contractor will be responsible for adhering to the sale boundaries as identified in the Invitation No. W912P5-5-08-0111 and/or designated by the Lake Cumberland Resource Manager or his representatives.

Sealed bids will be received until 2 p.m. Central Standard Time on February 22, 2008 at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Nashville District Real Estate Division, Room A-410, Estes Kefauver Federal Building, 801 Broadway, Nashville, Tennessee 37202-1070 and then publicly opened.
