Wolf Creek Dam barrier wall contract awarded

NASHVILLE, TENN. (July 23, 2008) – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Nashville District, announced today that a contract in the amount of \$341.4 million has been awarded to Treviicos Soletanche JV, for installation of a concrete barrier wall at Wolf Creek Dam in Russell County, KY. Work is expected to begin this fall with a contract performance period of four years.

The concrete barrier wall is the primary element of the Wolf Creek Dam Seepage Rehabilitation Project. The wall will be a combination of secant piles and rectangular panels installed through the earthen embankment to a depth of about 275 feet. It will go deep into the foundation rock to effectively cut off seepage through the limestone. The wall will extend eastward along the upstream embankment from the concrete section to the right abutment, a length of about 4,200 feet.
