## Kendall Annex Campground helps kids to play around



**JAMESTOWN, Ky., (Sept. 13, 2011)** — Kendall Annex Campground here has been welcoming families since 2006 and is wrapping up its sixth year of operation. For those of you who have not visited the Annex campground recently, it's getting a new addition to the area! It will soon have playground facilities conveniently located adjacent to the bathhouse and sites 113 and 114.

The new playground will house four slides, two crawl-thru tubes, and two slope inclines for kids to amuse themselves during their stay. Two benches will be placed in the area to allow parents to relax with their children and will be Americans with Disabilities Accessible. The area will have two lights for efficient illumination to make the playground a safe environment in the dusk hours. The lights will be on a timer system to ensure the lights do not disturb neighboring campers during the late hours of the night.

Ground work began Aug. 23, 2011 and completion of the playground is expected by Oct. 1, 2011. Kendall Annex campground is closing for the year on Oct. 30, 2011 and reopens for the 2012 camping season on May 11, 2012.
